THE HONORARY DEGREES

DOCTOR OF LAWS — LOWELL BLAKE MASON

Member of the Federal Trade Commission since 1945 and noted for his wise and statesmanlike role in the affairs of that important agency.

Distinguished lawyer and Northwestern alumnus, he has dedicated himself without interruption to the public welfare, serving effectively in Chicago's municipal administration and later as senator in the legislature of Illinois before assuming positions of national responsibility in Washington.

His successful career in government serves as an encouragement to others to devote their talents to the cause of civic betterment.

DOCTOR OF SCIENCE — GLENN THEODORE SEABORG

Outstanding research chemist at the University of California. He is the recognized leader of a group of young American chemists who have discovered and synthesized the transuranium elements, and as co-discoverer of plutonium and of other elements, he has contributed immeasurably to the advancement of nuclear chemistry and physics.

The impact of his accomplishments upon scientific techniques is increasing constantly, and as the results unfold, future generations will have reason to appreciate even more than we today, the vast significance of his research skill.
